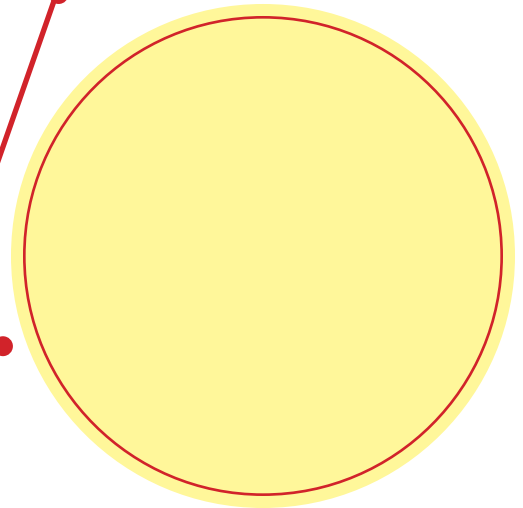
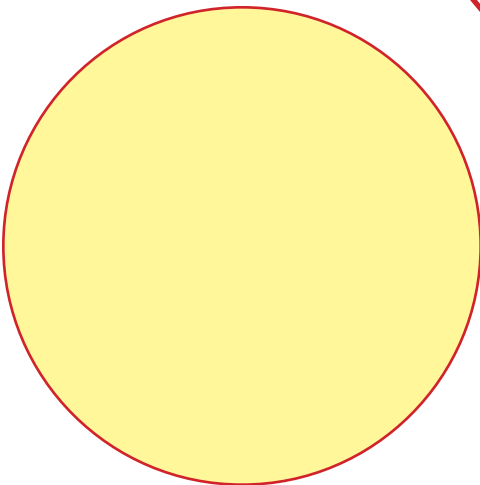
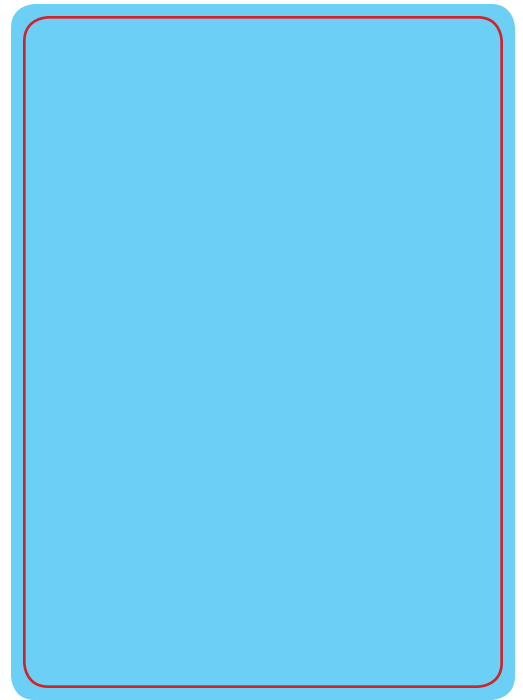
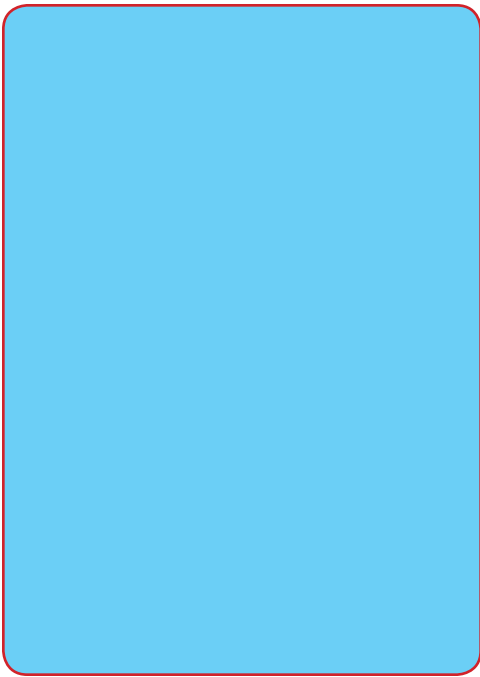




The examples on the left are what the finished label will look like.

The red lines represent where the die will cut.

To account for shift in the die cutting process, the label must be designed with bleed extending beyond where the die will cut. The examples on the right show how label content should bleed in relation to the dieline.
